

GENEVA COUNTY SOLID WASTE BULK WASTE PICKUP POLICY

Bulk Waste can be picked up at a residence by calling the Solid Waste Department at 334-684-5685 and placing a pickup order. Someone will go to the residence to determine the fee then we will call and give you a price quote for the pickup. All charges quoted must be **paid in full** in advance of the pickup. ****Please note that trees, limbs, yard debris, and any debris generated by a contractor will not be picked up by Geneva County Solid Waste. Disposal of contractor generated debris is the responsibility of the contractor****

EXAMPLES OF BULK WASTE ITEMS THAT WILL BE PICKED UP

1. HOUSEHOLD FURNITURE AND BEDDING, ETC.
2. LARGE APPLIANCES, SCRAP METAL, ETC.
3. FLOOR COVERINGS SUCH AS ROLLED CARPET AND RUGS
4. SMALL AMOUNTS OF LUMBER, BUILDING MATERIALS, CONSTRUCTION, AND REMODELING DEBRIS GENERATED BY THE RESIDENT OR PROPERTY OWNER
5. BATHROOM FIXTURES INCLUDING SINKS, LAVATORIES, COMMODES, AND BATHTUBS; HOT WATER HEATERS
6. TIRES (a per tire fee will be charged in addition to the above rate schedule)
TIRES MAY ALSO BE TAKEN TO THE TRANSFER STATION AT THE LANDFILL.
Tire disposal fee is \$1.25 each for passenger vehicle tires and \$4.00 each for Semi truck & trailer tires. Larger Tires from tractors, heavy equipment, etc. will not be accepted.

BULK WASTE ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP

1. HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE, AND CARDBOARD
2. TELEVISIONS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT
3. HAZARDOUS WASTE, LIQUID WASTE, OR PAINT CANS WITH WET PAINT
4. YARD WASTE INCLUDING LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, TREES, STUMPS, LIMBS, AND OTHER NATURAL VEGETATION
5. BATTERIES, OR PROPANE TANKS
6. ANY DEBRIS GENERATED BY A CONTRACTOR

*** SMALL ITEMS OF BULK WASTE INCLUDING CARDBOARD, CLOTHING, TOYS, AND OTHER LIKE ITEMS SHOULD CONTINUE TO BE PLACED IN THE REGULAR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE ROLL OUT CONTAINER.

*** ELECTRONIC ITEMS SUCH AS MICROWAVE OVENS, TV'S, VCR'S, COMPUTERS, AND OTHER SMALL ELECTRONICS SHOULD BE PLACED BESIDE THE REGULAR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE ROLL OUT CONTAINER.

PLEASE OBSERVE THESE GUIDELINES WHEN PLACING BULK WASTE NEAR THE ROAD ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY

1. Do not put bulk waste in the roadway, as this would create a traffic hazard.
2. Do not block gutters or any portion of the County drainage system.
3. Do not place bulk waste around fire hydrants, signposts, guide wires, power poles, over water meters over masonry work, or against fences.
4. Do not place bulk waste under any low hanging power lines, phone lines, television cables, low tree limbs, or near mailboxes.
5. Burning is not allowed on any County right-of-way. Geneva County Solid Waste will not pick up any burn debris.
